INITIAL DECISION

INTRODUCTION AND PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On February 12, 2019, Elois Dicks (“Employee”) appealed from Agency’s (“Office of the State Superintendent of Education”) final decision, effective December 19, 2018, removing her from her position as Bus Attendant, due to unauthorized absences of more than five days. This matter was assigned to me on March 3, 2019. I held a Prehearing Conference on May 23, 2019, after Employee established jurisdiction over this appeal. At some point, the parties informed the undersigned that they were in settlement discussions. Afterwards, I received a signed settlement agreement from the parties. The record is closed.

JURISDICTION

The Office has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 1-606.03(a) (2001).

ISSUE

Whether this matter should be dismissed.

ANALYSIS AND CONCLUSIONS

Since the parties have settled the matter, Employee’s petition for appeal is dismissed.
