INITIAL DECISION

PROCEDURAL BACKGROUND

On May 3, 2012, Employee appealed her removal by the agency for “any act which constitutes a criminal offense whether or not the act results in a conviction.” Specifically, Employee was accused of failing to report her District government wages while receiving unemployment insurance benefits. After a June 28, 2012 mediation session, the parties settled the matter. On July 16, 2012, the parties submitted their signed agreement along with an executed Praecipe of Dismissal that asked that this appeal be dismissed with prejudice.

JURISDICTION

The Office has jurisdiction pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 1-606.03 (2001).

ISSUE

Whether this matter should be dismissed with prejudice.

ANALYSIS AND CONCLUSION

Since the parties have settled the matter, Employee's petition for appeal is dismissed.

ORDER

It is hereby ORDERED that the petition in this matter is dismissed with prejudice.
