**ADDENDUM INITIAL DECISION<sup>1</sup>**

An Initial Decision was issued in this matter on January 31, 2020, reversing Agency's decision to remove Employee from his position. On September 10, 2020, Employee filed a Motion for Compliance/Enforcement. A Status Conference to address Employee's motion was held on September 17, 2020. This Addendum Decision is now being issued to clarify the order in the Initial Decision. The Initial Decision read, in pertinent part:

1. Employee shall be placed on unpaid administrative leave from the effective date of his termination—January 19, 2019—through the time he is able to have his SPO commission reinstated;
2. Agency shall immediately reimburse Employee all back-pay and benefits, if any, lost as a result of his termination.

To better describe the time frames described in number 1 and number 2 above, it is hereby **ORDERED** that:

1. Employee be retroactively placed on unpaid administrative leave from January 19, 2019, through June 10, 2019; and

2. Employee shall be reimbursed all back-pay and benefits from June 11, 2019, through March 18, 2020.
