INITIAL DECISION

INTRODUCTION AND PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On June 1, 2016, David Curtis (“Employee”) appealed from Agency’s (“Department of Insurance, Securities & Banking” or “DISB”) final decision, effective May 12, 2016, removing him from his position as Program Analyst, ED-301-12, for fraud and dishonesty. On August 24, 2016, the parties engaged in mediation and settled the matter. The settlement agreement was signed on October 13, 2016. This matter was assigned to me on November 3, 2016. The record is closed.

JURISDICTION

The Office has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to D.C. Official Code Ann. § 1-606.03(a) (2001).
