INITIAL DECISION

PROCEDURAL BACKGROUND AND FINDINGS OF FACT

Jane Waweru (“Employee”) was a Management Liaison Specialist for the District Department of Transportation (“Agency”). She was terminated from the Agency effective February 3, 2015, during her probationary period.

Employee filed an appeal with the Office of Employee Appeals (“OEA” or “the Office”) on January 20, 2015. Agency filed a Motion to Dismiss. On January 4, 2015, this matter was assigned to Undersigned. I issued an Order to Employee to address the issue of jurisdiction. On March 3, 2015, Employee withdrew her appeal. The record is now closed.

JURISDICTION

The Office has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 1-606.03 (2001).

ISSUE

Whether this appeal should be dismissed.

ANALYSIS AND CONCLUSION

Since Employee has voluntarily withdrawn her appeal, Employee's petition for appeal is dismissed.
