INITIAL DECISION

INTRODUCTION AND PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On November 23, 2016, Carlos Sandoval (Employee) appealed from Agency's (D.C. Department of General Services) final decision, effective October 25, 2016, removing him from his position as Deputy General Counsel, LX-1. This matter was assigned to me on February 2, 2017. After Agency submitted a Motion to Dismiss and Employee submitted his response, the parties informed the undersigned that they were in settlement discussions. On March 15, 2017, Employee submitted a Stipulation of Dismissal, indicating that they had settled. The record is closed.

JURISDICTION

The Office has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to D.C. Official Code Ann. § 1-606.03(a) (2001).

ISSUE

Whether this matter should be dismissed.
