INITIAL DECISION

PROCEDURAL BACKGROUND

On March 6, 2009, Employee filed a petition for appeal with this Office, challenging Agency's final decision to terminate her services as a Special Education Coordinator, ET 10-7, on allegations of dishonesty and falsification of business records. This matter was initially assigned to Judge Aikens-Arnold on May 27, 2008, before being reassigned to me on October 27, 2009. I held several status conferences before scheduling a hearing for December 15, 2010. Before the hearing, Agency submitted a note indicating that the parties have settled.

JURISDICTION

The Office has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to D.C. Official Code Ann. § 1-606.03(a) (2001).
