INITIAL DECISION

INTRODUCTION AND PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On August 7, 2017, Tuluv Price (Employee) appealed from Agency's (D.C. Public Schools) final decision, effective October 25, 2016, removing him from her position as a Performing Arts/Dance Teacher. This matter was assigned to me on October 3, 2017. The parties informed the undersigned that they were in settlement discussions through mediation. On December 13, 2017, Agency submitted a Motion to Dismiss with a signed copy of their settlement agreement, indicating that they had settled. The record is closed.
