INITIAL DECISION

INTRODUCTION AND PROCEDURAL BACKGROUND

On August 3, 2011, Valdora Celestine ("Employee") filed a petition for appeal with the Office of Employee Appeals ("OEA" or "Office") contesting the D.C.
