INITIAL DECISION

INTRODUCTION AND PROCEDURAL BACKGROUND

On July 31, 2014, Jonathan Moore, ("Employee") filed a Petition for Appeal with the Office of Employee Appeals ("OEA" or "Office") contesting the Office of the Chief Medical Examiner's ("Agency") decision to terminate him effective July 3, 2014.
