INITIAL DECISION

PROCEDURAL BACKGROUND AND FINDINGS OF FACT

On December 12, 2012, Employee, a Labor Economist, Grade 12-5, filed a petition for appeal of his 15-day suspension by Agency due to neglect of duty, insubordination, and misfeasance with this Office pursuant to D.C.
