INITIAL DECISION

INTRODUCTION AND PROCEDURAL BACKGROUND

On June 17, 2015, LaQuitta Fletcher ("Employee"), filed a Petition for Appeal with the Office of Employee Appeals ("OEA" or "Office") contesting the District of Columbia Public Schools'("Agency") decision to terminate her as a result of a Reduction in Force ("RIF"). On July 30, 2015, Agency filed its Answer to Employee's Petition for Appeal. This matter was assigned to the undersigned Administrative Judge ("AJ") on October 7, 2015. On October 14, 2015, I issued an Order requiring both parties to submit briefs in this matter. On October 23, 2015, Agency filed an "Agreed Withdrawal of Employee's Petition for Appeal", which indicated that Employee "withdraws her Petition for Appeal and requests that Michelle Harris, Administrative Judge, dismiss this case with prejudice." ¹ The record is now closed.
